The Attack on Liberty: Galatians

- 2:11 But when Cephas came to Antioch, I opposed him to his face, because he stood condemned.
- 12 For before certain men came from James, he was eating with the Gentiles; but when they came he drew back and separated himself, fearing the circumcision party.
- 13 And the rest of the Jews acted hypocritically along with him, so that even Barnabas was led astray by their hypocrisy.
- But when I saw that their conduct was <u>not</u> in <u>step</u> with <u>the truth of the gospel</u>,

 I said to Cephas before them all,

 'If you, though a Jew, live like a Gentile and not like a Jew, how can you <u>force</u> the Gentiles to <u>live like Jews</u>?"
- We ourselves are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners;
- 16 yet we know that a person is not justified <u>by</u> works of the law but <u>through</u> faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified <u>by</u> faith in Christ and not <u>by</u> works of the law, because <u>by</u> works of the law no one will be justified.
- I have been crucified with Christ.
 It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me.
 And the life I now live in the flesh I live by <u>faith</u> in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
- I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.
- 3:1 O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you?

 It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified.
- 2 Let me ask you only this:
 Did you receive the Spirit by (ek) works of the law or by (ek) hearing with faith?
- 3 Are you so foolish?

Having begun <u>by</u> the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?

- 4 Did you suffer so many things in vain if indeed it was in vain?
- 5 Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by (ek) works of the law, or by (ek) hearing with faith?
- 7 Know then that it is those of (ek) faith who are the sons of Abraham.
- And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed."
- 9 So then, those who are of (ek) faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.
- 3:13 Christ <u>redeemed</u> us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree"—
- so that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the promised Spirit through faith.
- 5:1 For <u>freedom</u> Christ has set us free; stand form therefore and do not submit again to the yoke of slavery.
